SMITH INSTRUMENT TESTER PART NO. 5001

If your Smith Instrument Tester is not operating properly, there is a possibility that the selector dial knob has been forced and is either slipping on the shaft or is in an improper relocated position so that it no longer points to the correct setting on the dial.

To correct this problem, remove the knob. Turn the shaft counterclockwise until it stops. At this point reinstall the knob, pointing toward the "CE" on the "bimetal lov" scale.

It may be necessary to file a flat on the shaft to coincide with the position of the allen screw with the knob pointing again to the "CE" of the "bimetal lov" scale.
